#### COOKIES

Cookies are small text files. They are downloaded to your device when you visit a website unless you have set your browser to stop them. We use several types of cookies that have been developed by Google. The types of cookie we use on our website may include:

#### Strictly necessary cookies

These are essential to the operation of our website and enable you to browse and use all features of the website.

### Functionality / preference cookies

Functionality cookies remember the choices you make when you visit our website. This includes, for example, your choice of language and text sizing. They remember your preferences on return visits and tailor your use of our website.

### Statistics / analytics cookies

These cookies collect anonymous information about your use of our website such as the pages you visit most often, how you arrived at our website and error messages you may receive. These do not collect any personal information and are used to improve our website performance.



#### Marketing cookies / pixels

These are placed by trusted third-party suppliers and help us count visitors to our website. They provide aggregated information which we use to monitor the popularity of our services.
